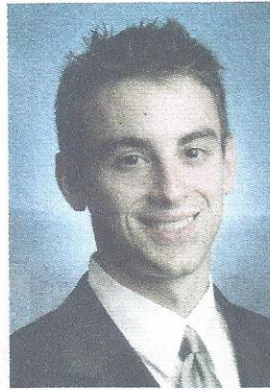

Darren Heitner already is a partner at 28 at Wolfe Law Miami, managed by prominent entertainment lawyer Richard C. Wolfe.

Gifted with an entrepreneurial spirit, Heitner formed his own sports agency, Dynasty Dealings LLC, in 2007. He represented about 40 clients by the time he was 23 and just a second-year law student.

His clients include Mike "The Situation" Sorrentino from MTV's "Jersey Shore," National Hockey League defenseman Jack Johnson of the Columbus Blue Jackets, high-profile sports agent Drew Rosenhaus, Miami sports management mogul David Sugarman, fast-rising rapper French Montana, the controversial former National Basketball Association referee Tim Donaghy and BMX professional Mike Spinner.

Heitner is well-known for his Sports Agent Blog, which covers the industry. He is a regular contributor to Forbes.com's SportsMoney and teaches sport agency management as an adjunct lecturer in the Kinesiology Department at Indiana University.

He also co-founded Collegiate Sports Advisors LLC, promoted as the only firm offering a full suite of services for all of a university's compliance needs.

Heitner is involved in The Florida Bar entertainment, arts and sports law section and the national Sports Lawyers Association. He speaks across the country on sports law.

Heitner is a 2010 graduate of the University of Florida law school and was admitted to The Florida Bar in 2010.
